Dept will recall that in Campora and Juan Peron eras thereexers extreme leftist was appointed head of INTA and there followed an anti-US vendetta which resulted in firings and threats against those with US connections or sympaties. While the leadership of INTA has changed and it has become more less unwilling to work with US, a substantial amount of hostility remained among staff, which was widely known among Argentine colleagues as of predominantly leftist sympathies.
